We appreciate your support, which helps keep our kitchens running and our students fueled for academic success by making healthy meal choices.

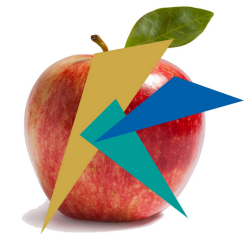
